



Locust Street Library Facility Saint Louis University

The SLU Locust Street Library Facility (LSLF), located at 3301 Locust Street, holds valuable but less frequently used material in a high-density, climate-controlled, and closed-stack environment. The Facility houses over 500,000 volumes. Each item appears in the SLU Libraries Catalog with the location "Locust Street Facility."

Collections at the Locust Street Library Facility include:

- Most bound journals published before 2000, and journals that are no longer received in print
- Government Documents
- Law treatises
- SLU theses and dissertations
- Second or third copies of monographs

Transfer of these materials to the Locust Street Library Facility makes space available in the SLU Libraries for new materials and for valuable teaching and study space.

Obtaining Articles from Items at the Locust Street Library Facility (LSLF)

- Request the article via Interlibrary Loan at <http://libraries.slu.edu/services/ill.html>. Create an ILLiad account if you do not already have one.
- In most cases, articles will be delivered electronically within 24 hours of your request, Monday-Friday. You will receive an email at your SLU email address when the article is ready for download.

NEED A BOOK OR OTHER ITEM?

Obtaining Books, Government Documents, and Other Items from the Locust Street Library Facility (LSLF)

- Request books, government documents, individual journal volumes, or other items using the REQUEST button in the SLU Libraries Catalog.
- Books will be delivered to the Library of your choice for pickup, usually within 24 hours, Monday-Friday. You will receive an email at your SLU email address when the item is ready for pickup or use in the Library.
