CIRCULATION DEPARTMENT 977-3087

Located at the entrance to Pius Library, you can

- Check out your books at the circulation desk.
- Request and pick up items from Interlibrary Loan.
- Check out print items placed on Reserve.
- Check out a listening or viewing room for audio/visual materials that do not circulate.
- Check out a study room for 3 hours.
- Rent a locker for \$3.00 per academic year.

Your Saint Louis University (SLU) ID serves as your library card as well as your ticket into Pius Library.

REFERENCE DEPARTMENT 977-3103

Located on Level 1, Reference is the place to

- Search online databases and the library catalog for articles and books for research papers.
- Find specific information on a topic, or get help selecting, evaluating, and using resources.
- Get help from librarians in person or by phone, e-mail or chat (<http://chatref.slu.edu/>).
- Type papers, design PowerPoint presentations and Web pages, or create an Excel spreadsheet.
- Use one of 60 computers available.

Other services offered include course-related library presentations, orientation tours, CD-ROM databases, print indexes and reference books, an individualized Research Assistance Program (RAP), and a variety of library guides and instructional handouts. **Printing** from reference computers requires that you **add Billiken Bucks to your SLU ID**. A Billiken Bucks Pay Station to add money to your card with cash or credit card is available in Pius'

Lobby. Black & white computer printouts are \$.09 per page; color printouts are \$.50 per page.

SLU LIBRARIES CATALOG

Access to the SLU Libraries Catalog is available on all floors of Pius Library and via the SLU Library's home page, <http://libraries.slu.edu>.

The SLU library catalog lists materials available in all Saint Louis University Libraries. You also can request books from other SLU Libraries as well as from MOBIUS (Missouri Bibliographic Information User System), a consortium of academic libraries in the state of Missouri.

INTERLIBRARY LOAN (ILL) 977-3104

If your SLU Catalog or MOBIUS search for a certain book, article, or other item is unsuccessful, you can request the materials from another library through Interlibrary Loan. Pius Library's Interlibrary Loan request and electronic delivery service, ILLiad, <http://illiad/illiad/xii/logon.html>, is available to take your requests. You also may access ILLiad from Interlibrary Loan on the Library's home page, <http://libraries.slu.edu>.

SERIALS/PERIODICALS 977-3110

Located on Level 2, this area handles the periodicals and newspapers received by Pius Library and the Library's microform collections, including microfilm copies of dissertations and theses written at SLU. To locate periodicals and newspapers, check the SLU Libraries Catalog for a call number. Current issues are shelved in Serials / Periodicals. Back issues are shelved in the book stacks or are available on microform in Serials / Periodicals. CAFÉ LIBROS & LOBBY

Enjoy snacks, sandwiches, soups, smoothies, and espresso at the café near the Pius entrance. This area on Level 1 also offers the latest issues of popular magazines and newspapers and a New Books display. Many people come here to read casually or to meet friends.

ST. LOUIS ROOM (Archives) 977-3109

For those of you who want to dig into the University's history, a trip to the Saint Louis Room on Level 3 is in

order. Here you will find Saint Louis University publications, photographs and memorabilia. You will also find the University's rare book collection.

RESERVE MATERIALS 977-3585

Reserve materials are located in the Circulation Department. Here you will find materials that your instructors put on hold for your use, for two-hour, three-hour, or three-day checkout. SLU also has an electronic reserves system (ERes).

GOVERNMENT DOCUMENTS 977-3590

U.S. Government Documents are a rich source of information. Reference materials and electronic resources are located in the Reference Department on Level 1. Most documents are on the Lower Level. Many are not listed in the SLU Libraries Catalog, so please ask for help at the reference desk.

LEWIS ANNEX

This part of the library can be entered only from the Northeast corner of Level 2. Oversized books with call numbers beginning with A through P and other materials with call numbers beginning with A through C are shelved in the Lewis Annex.

PHOTOCOPIERS

Photocopiers are located throughout the building. You must add Billiken Bucks to your SLU ID to photocopy for \$.09 per page. If you use coins, the cost is \$.15 per page. Color prints and photocopies are \$.50 per page. Billiken Bucks also work in our microfilm and microfiche reader/printers on Level 2 and laser print stations in Reference.

UNIVERSITY SUPPORT SERVICES

An undergraduate writing center and a testing center are available on Level 3 of the Anheuser-Busch Wing and the Graduate Writing Center is in Pius Room 503.
